

Northeast Wisconsin Boys Basketball League
Game Day Execution for Hosts and Visiting Programs

1. Host school to provide two WIAA officials for every game.
2. Payment of officials:
 - Each team will bring \$30.00 cash for each game played.
 - The team representative will pay the host representative before entering the gym.
 - The host representative will pay the officials.
3. Host school to maintain a scoreboard/clock and official scorebook for every court. Official scorebook needs only to keep track of individual fouls, team fouls, team points, and time-outs. NWBBL Game Rules must be on every scorer's table. Each team provides a person for the scoreboard/clock OR scorebook. Official scorebook needs only to keep track of: individual fouls, team fouls, team points and time-outs.
4. Host school should be prepared to provide a first aid kit.
5. Each team will supply their own warm-up basketballs. One team will provide the basketball to be used during the game. Game basketballs will not be provided by the host school. All coaches please gather/control your basketballs before, during and after basketball games.
6. Each program must pay \$125.00 at the beginning of the season for a league registration fee. Make check out to "Sheboygan Basketball Club" and mail to Tyler Thomas at 4210 N. 29 Sheboygan 53083.
7. Weather cancellations must be made at least two hours prior to the game by the Host Contact Person calling the Contact Person at each visiting program from the Contact List.
8. A team that does not show up to play will have to pay an automatic \$200.00 (exception was agreed upon that if a team does not attend their games due to severe weather issues that a \$60 fee will be assessed to cover the referee costs.) In addition, once the NWBBL game schedule goes FINAL on the website, a \$200 fine will be assessed if a team cancels and is unable to "fix" their issue within 15 days of the scheduled game date. Check can be made out to "Sheboygan Basketball Club" and mailed to address in #6.
9. It is the responsibility of each organization to insure that coaches, players, and spectators represent your organization with dignity and respect. Although winning is important, we will stress that sportsmanship is paramount. We should view ourselves as a community coming together to benefit our youth.
10. Photos and videos may be taken but cannot be used for commercial purposes. Players cannot be identified by name on photos or video without written consent from the player's parent/guardian.

11. Host programs can use any of the following as a means of revenue generation on game day:

- a. Admission Fee--\$3 for adults, \$2 for students, age 5 and under free, two coaches per team are free, all host teams will charge the same.
- b. Concessions
- c. Fundraisers
- d. Games/Contests
- e. 50/50 Raffle
- f. Others as approved by the league Primary Representatives
